OUR MISSION

PCBAA is a consortium of U.S.-based companies that advocate for U.S. domestic production of printed circuit boards, or PCBs, and the materials they are made of, as well as the protection of their supply chain.

PCBs are the central nervous system of microelectronics. Without PCBs, computer chips cannot communicate with the devices or systems they power. From everyday consumer electronics to critical national defense systems, modern technology depends on PCBs.

Over the past 20 years PCB production has moved to other countries, primarily in Asia, as overseas costs were driven down by foreign government subsidies. The U.S. once produced over 26% of the world's PCBs. Today the number is 4%. This dependence on other countries creates risk for both business and national security.
